
What is School To Work?

School to Work provides transition programs and services for students with disabilities in grades 7-12, whose expected outcome is community-based employment. Training includes classroom and community-based instruction. Services are provided within the special education continuum of services, including indirect and direct teacher consulting, resource room programs, and special classes. The Arc offers a variety of programs to meet individual student's needs with the ability to customize these programs for school districts.









Who is providing these services?

The Arc, Oneida-Lewis Chapter, in collaboration with Oneida-Herkimer-Madison BOCES, provides students with disabilities meaningful community-based integrative preparation for employment to assist with the transition from school-to-work.
